## SOME OF THE BRANCHES OF THE BOSLEY FAMILY

The following notes were compiled from several sources. Mrs. Rebecca Bosley Carrick had made a life study of the connections during her life and she helped the writer to put her records and data into the form 20tlined here. Some information as to the early Bosleys was had from the History of Baltimore which was published in three volumes (1912) by the Lewis Historical Publishing Company. Some data were had from old Bibles in the possession of Miss Eleanor Schmidt of Douglaston, Long Island, N. Y.; and other, though limited, information was obtained from D. A. R. records. The kinship connection presented here is far from complete. As no study was made of public records there is even a possibility of inaccuracy; but interested genealogists have, at least, a beginning for making further studies which, we think, could be effected from wills, deeds, court orders and records of births and deaths to be found at the court house in Towson and at the State Capitol in Annapolis. The story of many of the Bosleys is related in Talbott Family of West River, Maryland (1907) by Mrs. Ida M. Shirk.

- 1 Walter Bosley, a barrister at law in England, emigrated to the Colony of MaryTand about the middle of the 17th Century and settled in Baltimore County. He died Nov., 1715. He had received an extensive grant of land at Meredith's Ford, in Dulaney's Valley, on the Gunpowder River. He came from Staffordshire, England, where the Bosleys had long resided. Captain Joshua Marsh married Temperance Harryman. Capt. Marsh was the son of Thomas Marsh who was the founder of the family in Maryland. Thomas Marsh had settled in colonial times in Baltimore County, east of the Gunpowder River and north of Dulaney's Valley, where he possessed a large tract of land. Rebecca Marsh's brothers and sisters were, - Stephen Marsh who married a widow Owings who had two children (Louise Owings and Rebecca Owings; Josiah Marsh who married Eliza Taylor (no issue); and Elijah, Capt. Joshua, Jr., Beale, Grafton and Dennis, all of these unmarried. The foregoing information is from the record of Dr. Ben Rush Ridgely a former owner of Barrett's Delight.
